

Simple Steps to Get Started


- Lead Agency admin selects the <u>assessment view</u>.
- Check that <u>all users</u> are in the system. (If users are missing, add them.)
- Create classrooms for the current rating period.
- Now, <u>add children</u> to the system. (Use either the upload template or add them one at a time.)

- Has all the other permissions of an Agency Admin



Suggestions for Completing the DRDP

- notes that will help to complete more than one
- Observe children daily (indoors and outdoors), keep running records, journals, work samples, and anecdotal notes.
- learning opportunities.
- ▶ Know the DRDP contents and make observation → Use time management and review your evidence before the due date of the assessment.
 - Use simple recording methods. Use a journal for each child. Encourage staff and parents to note observations, anecdotal records, and share photos showing children's progress and growth.
- ▶ Choose a domain to focus on, look for integrated → Review and reflect on gathered observations and documentation to inform and complete the DRDP
