

DRDP Online 2025 Tip Sheet

Generating Group Detail Reports in DRDP Online

The DRDP Online Group Detail Report provides domain-level scale scores for a group of children. It provides percentages by measure for each developmental level for the current year-to-date. This report can be generated for a class, an agency, or any specific group of children that you choose for agency planning or reporting purposes.

1. Viewing the Group Report

1. Log in to DRDP Online.org with your username and password to get started.
2. In the menu on the left, choose **Reports**. (Several types of report options are in the dropdown.) Choose **2025 Group Detail Report** (*Figure 1-1*).

3. Next, select Rating Period, Site, and Classroom. Selecting an Age Group is optional. (State and Agency will auto-populate.)
4. Under Additional Filters, select **None**.
5. Select **Show Report** to view it online or **Download Report** to view or save it as a PDF (*Figure 1-2 below*).

2. Domains and Developmental Levels

The report will chart domain and developmental levels via two color bars depending on which skills are being assessed. Only children with ratings completed in specific domains will be included in the results.

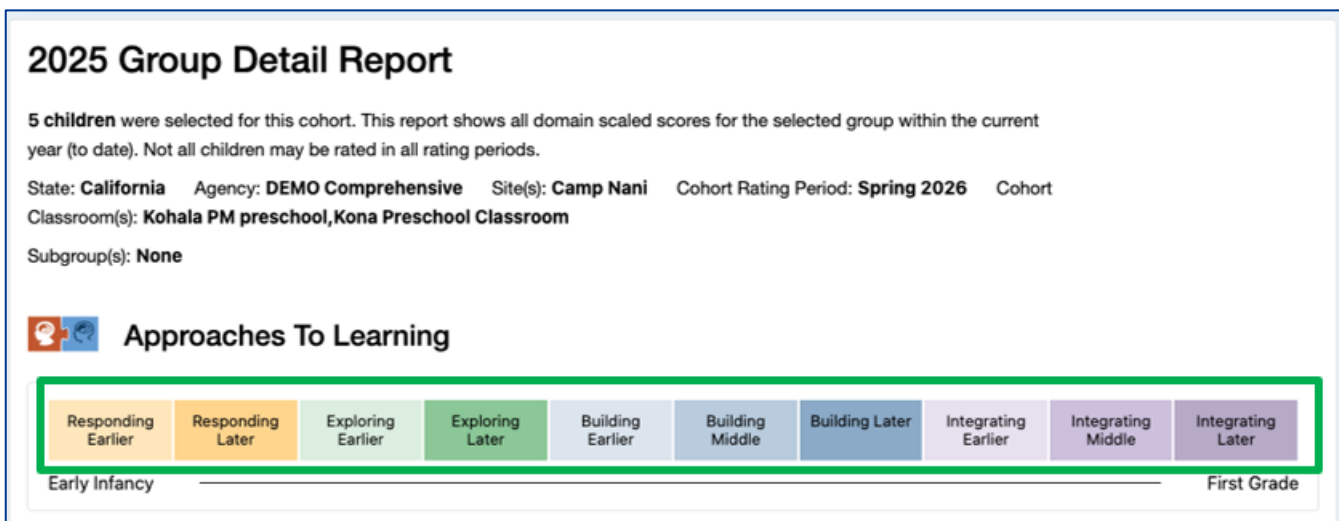


Figure 2-1: Developmental Levels

1. The first color-coded bar under each description of the developmental domain shows the developmental level labels from Responding Earlier on the left to Integrating Later on the right (*Figure 2-1*).

2. The first domain is Approaches to Learning (*Figure 2-2 below*). Scroll down for the other domains.
3. The “n” on the far left indicates the number of children in the domain rating (See *Figure 2-2 below*).



Figure 2-2: Number of Children in the Domain, Median Score, and Percentage, and the Number of Children Rated at that Developmental Level

- The other color-coded section of the bar is a percentage and a number representing the percentage of children rated within that developmental level (Figure 2-2).
- A black vertical line in the color bar for each domain indicates the median score for the group for this domain (Figure 2-2).

The developmental levels of the English Language Development domain differ from those of the other domains.

2.2. Developmental Level Detail

- The Group Detail Report will also include detailed scores for each measure within each domain. Each measure will show the total number and percentage of children in that cohort who received ratings at each level (See Figure 2.2-1 below).
