



Getting Started: DRDP Online for Teachers

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Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide an overview of the DRDP Online website for teachers.

Instructions

The Teacher's Role

A teacher may access information for the group of children in their class and is responsible for completing the Desired Results Developmental Profile (DRDP) for each child during a rating period. DRDP Online has two roles for teachers: *Teacher* and *Teacher of Record*. These two roles have the following permissions:


- Search for and view **Child/Children**.
- View Classes.
- Enter, view, and edit **Child Ratings**.
- Lock **Child Ratings** (ONLY Teacher of Record has this permission).
- Run and view reports.
- View teachers assigned to your class.

Accounts assigned to the Teacher or Teacher of Record role may be assigned to multiple classes. In addition, classes can have multiple Teachers assigned. The Teacher role's primary responsibility is entering ratings for a child and pulling reports. The Teacher of Record has the unique role of also locking ratings.

First Steps

*If you do not currently have a DRDP Online user account, please contact your site administrator, agency administrators, or lead agency administrator who oversees the account.

1. Go to the DRDP Online website in your internet browser: www.drdponline.org.





2. Enter your username (complete email address) into the email line.

Classes and Children

As a Teacher or Teacher of Record, you do not have permission to add classes or children. However, the administrator or data entry role is assigned permission to add classes or children.

1. Select **My Classes** in the left menu.

2. Teachers and Teachers of Record will be provided with a list of all the classrooms to which the administrator assigned them. The information provided includes the name of the class, the rating period, the site name, and the number of children enrolled in that class.

From the child list, ratings can be entered by selecting the numbers below. The first number represents how many measures have been completed in that domain for that child. The second number represents how many total measures need to be completed in that domain.

Any child with a zero (0) for their first number has not had any measures rated, as highlighted in the screenshot above. Children may have different requirements regarding the number of measures required in a particular domain. For example, children with an IEP in a preschool class using the DRDP Preschool Essential View will automatically be assigned the fundamental view.

The UR column has check boxes that are selected when the measure cannot be rated due to excessive absences of the child.

Note:

- a. The EM checkbox will be grayed out and disabled if the last level for that measure has been rated.
- b. A rating can be erased by selecting the UR check box twice.

9. Once you've completed all the domains required, you do not need to return to the previous page to move to the next child. Select **Save**:

And then select **Next**:

10. Once a record is reviewed by someone with the Teacher of Record role, that child's ratings can be locked by selecting the **Lock** button.

If all ratings have been completed in a class, the Teacher of Record can lock all records for that class from the **Input Rating** page by clicking **Lock**.

Note: Until a record is locked, it will not be available in reporting.
