



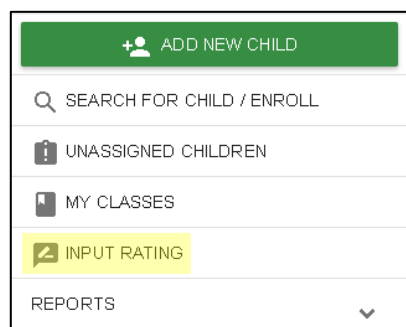
## How to Enter Ratings Tip Sheet

### Introduction

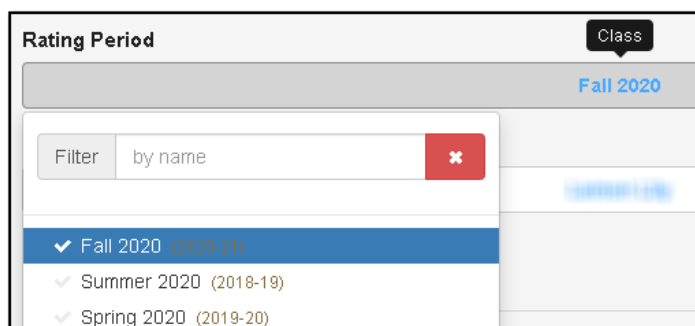
Users with the Teacher or Teacher of Record role assigned to a class may enter ratings for children enrolled in their assigned class. In addition, users with the Teacher of Record role may lock ratings.

### Ratings

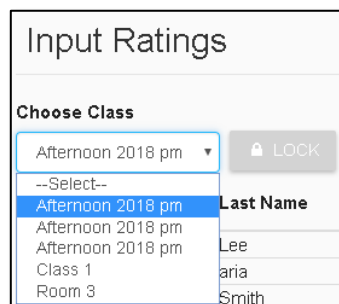
1. Once logged into DRDP Online, select the **Input Rating** button in the left menu.



2. From the **Rating Period** drop-down menu, select the period to which you would like to add a rating.



3. From the **Class** menu, select the class to which you would like to add a rating.



**Note:** Children are grouped by age level and will appear as duplicate classes in the drop-down list if there is more than one age level in the class.



- From the Age Group/Instrument menu, select the Age Group to which you would like to add a rating.

- The list of children includes the child's name, ID, developmental domains, rating completion lock, lock date, assessment date, age group, teacher, site, and status.

From the child list, ratings can be entered by selecting the domain number. The first number represents how many measures have been completed in that domain for that child. The second number represents how many total measures need to be completed in that domain.

Any child with a zero (0) for their first number has no measures reported, as highlighted in the screenshot above. Different children may have different requirements regarding the number of measures required in a particular domain. For example, children with an IEP in a preschool class using the DRDP Preschool Essential View will automatically be assigned the fundamental view.



6. Once a domain has been selected for a child, the rating page will load at the location of the child and domain selected.

7. For each measure, indicate the developmental level by selecting the circle for that level.

8. Once a level is chosen, check the box in the EM column if the child is emerging to the next level.

**Note:** A rating can be erased by selecting the UR check box twice.



9. Once you've completed all the domains required, you do not need to return to the previous page to move to the next child. Select **Save**.

And then select **Next**:

10. Once a record is reviewed by someone with the Teacher of Record role, that child's ratings can be locked by selecting the **Lock** button.

If all ratings have been completed in a class, the Teacher of Record can lock all records for that class from the **Input Rating** page by clicking **Lock**.

**Note:** Until a record is locked, it will not be available in reporting.

When a Teacher of Record locks a class, the entire class is given the same assessment date.

If children were assessed on different dates, the Teacher of Record can lock each child individually.

This can be done by selecting a child's domain number and, when the rating record opens, selecting **Lock**, then selecting the date of assessment from the calendar.
