

DRDP Online Tip Sheet

Set and Lock Rating Views in DRDP Online 2023 for Administrators

At the beginning of the school year, only the designated Lead Agency Administrator can set and lock the rating views. The administrator must select and lock the view of the Desired Results Developmental Profile (DRDP) assessment for the entire agency or program. Please visit Desired Results for Children and Families /DRDP Instrument and Forms for a description of each view of the assessment.

1. Set and Lock the DRDP View

Please complete the steps below to set and lock your agency's chosen DRDP view(s).




Figure 1.1: DRDP Online Setup Drop-Down Menu

1. Once logged in to DRDP Online, select the Setup Menu option from the left menu (*Figure 1.1*).




Figure 1.2: Ratings View Setup

2. Select Ratings View Setup (Figure 1.2 below).

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


Figure 1.3: Select Agency Default Views

3. Select a view from the drop-down menu for each age level listed below or select N/A from the drop-down menu if your agency does not have a specific age level (*Figure 1.3*).

Age Levels

- Infant/Toddler (IT) Birth to 36 months
- Preschool (PS) —Three years to kindergarten entry
- Transitional Kindergarten (TK) First year of a two-year kindergarten program
- Kindergarten (K) All children enrolled in kindergarten classes
- School Age (SA) Kindergarten through 12 years

Ratings Views

- The Comprehensive views provide for assessing children's learning and development in domains related to all areas of the Infant/Toddler Learning and Development Foundations or Preschool Learning Foundations, covering the full range of learning and development that early childhood curricula generally cover.
- The **Fundamental** view provides for assessing preschool children's learning and development in the key domains associated with school readiness.
- The Essential views provide for assessing children's learning and development with selected measures in key domains.
- There are two versions of the DRDP-SA© (2010) assessment instruments. The Complete Version includes academic domains typically assessed by K–12 teachers.
 The Simplified Version does not duplicate K–12 assessments.




Figure 1.4: Select Agency Default Views Save and Lock Button
