Andres is conducting a simple investigation using various strategies to get the paint out of the bottle. One source of information is his classmates.</p>

Andres tries on his own to get the paint out of the bottle by squeezing it several times. He then gets help from a friend who tries to tap the bottle on the table before squeezing it again. Next, he tries to tap the bottle himself before squeezing it. He removes the cap from the bottle and checks to make sure there is paint. He tries this a few times as well. Finally, he puts the bottle by the sink. When the girl grabs the bottle, takes the lid off, and pulls off the paper lid to get the paint out, he takes the bottle and pours out the paint to use for his painting. Andres never gets frustrated but keeps persisting in trying to get the paint out.</p>
