

Video Example: Rebecca Writes a Sentence Transcript

Rebecca writes: “I like the leau vecus is”

(She gets up from her chair, and goes to the word wall, we see her looking at the words, she grabs one of the cards and comes back to her seat. Back at her seat we see the word card she took is “pretty”. She writes and when she gets up to go put the card back, she trips on a boy that was behind her.)

Rebecca: He dropped me.

Adult: Oh, be careful.

Rebecca: He dropped me. I was walking and then he dropped me. (She comes back to her seat, and continues writing. She hands her paper to her teacher.)

Rebecca: Ms. Tinajera

Ms. Tinajera: I like the lion because it’s pretty. I like the sh... the what? What does this say?

Rebecca: Story.

Ms. Tinajera: The story, oh I like that. So is that a question mark? Yes, are you going to ask a question?

Rebecca: Sounds out the word “story”, and corrects it. She shows her teacher.

Ms. Tinajera: Ok, we’ll put a period there. Are you asking a question?

Rebecca: Traces over the period at the end of the sentence. Then we see a close up of her work.
