

Video Example: Jesse and the Seatbelt Transcript

Teacher: Where do you want to travel?

Girl: On a spaceship?

Teacher: Where are you going to travel to?

Girl: To the moon

Teacher: To the moon? Ok, draw yourself.

Jesse: I want to go on the train.

Teacher: You want to go on the train? And where are you going to go on the train?

Jesse: Disneyland

Teacher: Disneyland, are you going to take the metro?

Jesse: Yeah (Jesse writes his name correctly and legibly on his paper.)

Other student: I'm buckling myself.

Teacher: You're what?

Other student: I'm buckling myself.

Teacher: You buckled yourself? Why do we need to buckle ourselves?
