

## Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Credit FAQ

### DRDP Teacher Training

**CEU credit:** Continuing education units (CEU) are offered for various professional development courses. CEU are used when employers, relicensure agencies, school districts and other authorities require a specified number of hours of noncredit study for career advancement. CEU are not accepted for academic credit and do not apply toward degree programs or meet teaching credential requirements.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What unit should I choose?</li> <li>How many units do I get?</li> </ul>	If you are getting more units for an increase in pay you may want to go for the 1 continuing education unit. (This may require your employer's prior notice.) CEU cannot be applied towards a degree.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How much does it cost?</li> </ul>	The cost for 1 continuing education unit (CEU) is \$75.00.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How do I register?</li> <li>How do I pay?</li> <li>Can I write a check?</li> <li>To whom do I write the check?</li> </ul>	Fill out and submit the CSUCI Extended Education enrollment form and use credit card to pay. <b>*Summer 2025 course numbers are valid from 5/24/2025 to 8/8/2025. Students completing the training after August 8, 2025, must register for Fall 2025 credit.</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why do I have to give my SSN?</li> </ul>	You must provide your Social Security number as you are actually registering in a course with CSUCI.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What do I have to do to in the course?</li> <li>What are the requirements for the course?</li> <li>Do I have homework?</li> </ul>	Attendance at the one (1) day training is required. You must <u>sign in and out</u> at the training. The sign in sheet will be sent to CSUCI to verify attendance. You are not required to turn in an assignment to receive CEU.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is this professional growth?</li> <li>How do I get professional growth?</li> <li>Will we get a certificate?</li> </ul>	Professional growth is something that your agency approves for each participant. A certificate is given out to each attendee to verify attendance. CEU are true college credits. If you have registered for the course, you will receive a separate certificate for your units.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How do I request a transcript?</li> </ul>	If you would like an official transcript, you will need to request from CSUCI. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do I get a grade?</li> </ul>	With continuing education units (CEU), participants receive a Credit or No Credit report.
