

DRDP (2025) Infant-Toddler Videos: Playdough

A good piece of evidence might address multiple measures. Rather than assigning a developmental level, this video clip could serve as evidence for the measures listed in this chart.

Domain	Measure definition	Why this video clip might be evidence
Foundational Language Development (FLD) Measure 2: Using Language (Expressive)	Child uses increasingly complex language, including vocabulary, sentences, questions, narratives, and explanations, in their home language, English, sign language, or Augmentative and Alternate Communication (AAC). Select measure FLD 2 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Later.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Later. The boy tells the teacher how many scissors he has to play with the playdough, and when his peer walks into the room, he says his name.
Social Emotional Development (SED) Measure 2: Social Awareness	Child shows a developing awareness and acceptance of others' thoughts, perspectives, and individual characteristics. Select measure SED 2 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Earlier.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Earlier. When one of his peers walks into the classroom, he says his name and looks at his teacher.
Social Emotional Development (SED) Measure 3: Relationships and Reciprocal Interactions with Familiar Adults	Child develops close relationships with one or more familiar adults (including family members) and interacts in an increasingly competent and cooperative manner with familiar adults. Select measure SED 3 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Later.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Later. The boy participates in familiar activities, like playing with playdough, and interacts with his teacher.
Social Emotional Development (SED) Measure 4: Relationships and Interactions with Peers	Child develops and maintains close relationships with one or more peers and becomes increasingly competent and cooperative in peer interactions. Select measure SED 4 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Later.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Later. The boy is playing with playdough and playdough tools; he shares the space and tools with his peers.
Cognition and Math (COG: MATH) Measure 3: Numbers and Counting	Child shows developing understanding of number and quantity. Select measure COG: MATH 3 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Later.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Later. The boy shares with his teacher that he has two scissors to play with the playdough.
Physical Development (PD) Measure 4: Fine Motor Manipulative Skills	Child demonstrates increasing precision, strength, coordination, and efficiency when using muscles of the hand for play and functional tasks. Select measure PD 4 and read the descriptor and examples for Exploring Later.	This video might be evidence for Exploring Later. The boy uses both hands to explore and manipulate the playdough and the scissors.
