

Desired Results Developmental Profile Teacher Training Academic Unit FAQ

Q	A
How many units will I receive?	You will receive 1 unit. An academic unit is applicable to a higher education degree. If you are getting your BA/BS or MA/MS, you may want to complete the 1 academic unit. This unit counts as an elective course.
How much does it cost?	The cost for 1 academic unit is \$125.00
- How do I register? - How do I pay? - Can I write a check? - To whom do I write the check?	Fill out the attached CSUCI Extended Education enrollment form, print it, and enroll by fax, mail or phone at the numbers and address provided. <i>Please note course numbers are valid only for assignments received by WestEd from January 20-May 29, 2020. Students submitting assignments after May 29, 2020 must register for Summer 2020 academic credit.</i>
Why do I have to give my SSN?	You must provide your Social Security number because you are actually registering in a course with CSUCI.
- What do I have to do to in the course? - What are the requirements for the course? - Do I have homework? - Are there any tests? - When and where do I submit my assignment?	Attendance at the one (1) day training is required. You must <u>sign in and out</u> to verify your attendance. The sign in/out sheet will be sent to CSUCI. You will also need to complete the following assignments: (1) Read the DRDP and DRDP User's Guide (2) The assignment consists of completing the DRDP in own classroom. The assignment is graded on the understanding of observation and recording techniques NOT on the skills of the child. There are no tests; however, the assignment must be completed within 60 days of the training. You will submit your completed assignment to the following address: DR Fee-Based Training, 333 N. Will I get a refund if I do not complete the assignments?	There are NO refunds. Please plan ahead to avoid disappointment.
- Is this professional growth? - How do I get professional growth? - Will we get a certificate?	Professional growth is something that your agency approves for each participant. A certificate is given out to each attendee to verify attendance. This unit is actually true college credit. When you register you are enrolled in the university. If you have registered in the course, you will receive a separate certificate for your unit.

Assignment for Academic Units

Course Title: Desired Results Developmental Profile Teacher Training

Dept. & Course #: California State University at Channel Islands (CSUCI) ECS 907
(Academic Credit)

Description:

This one-day training course concentrates on one component of the Desired Results training already approved for academic credit. The component it covers is the Desired Results Developmental Profile. This training is offered for teachers of childcare agencies in state-funded and other programs. One unit of academic credit will be offered to students based on their attendance in class and the successful completion of the assignment. Students must fill out the CSUCI Extended Education enrollment form which is also available on the Desired Results website www.desiredresults.us/academic-credit

The class will meet in person once for eight hours. Students will be given an assignment that they will take back to the classroom. The remaining seven contact hours will include the assignment itself. All contact for the remaining hours will be via phone, email, or fax.

Assignment for Academic Unit ONLY:

Each student is required to complete the DRDP in the classroom. The DRDP has to be completed within 60 days of the class meeting. It is expected that students will use the knowledge they received during the class meeting to fill out the profile. This includes normal daily observation, anecdotal records, etc. It is important that students show HOW they filled out the assessment by providing evidence about why the form was marked in a certain way. Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Credit FAQ

DRDP Teacher Training CEU credit: Continuing education units (CEU) are offered for various professional development courses. CEU are used when employers, relicensure agencies, school districts and other authorities require a specified number of hours of noncredit study for career advancement. CEU are not accepted for academic credit and do not apply toward degree programs or meet teaching credential requirements.

- What unit should I choose? - How many units do I get?	If you are getting more units for an increase in pay you may want to go for the 1 continuing education unit. (This may require your employer's prior notice.) CEU cannot be applied towards a degree.
How much does it cost?	The cost for 1 continuing education unit (CEU) is \$112.50.
- How do I register? - How do I pay? - Can I write a check? - To whom do I write the check?	Fill out the attached CSUCI Extended Education enrollment form, print it, and enroll by fax, mail or phone at the numbers and address provided. You may pay for the course with a credit card (MasterCard), or by check made out to CSUCI. Cash is not accepted.
Why do I have to give my SSN?	You must provide your Social Security number as you are actually registering in a course with CSUCI.
- What do I have to do to in the course? - What are the requirements for the course? - Do I have homework?	Attendance at the one (1) day training is required.
