# Generating Cohort Progress Reports in DRDP Online 2023

The Cohort Progress Report provides domain scale scores for a selected cohort of children. This report lets you choose certain filters, such as a program type.

The report shows all domain-scaled scores for the specific scores within the current year-to-date.

# 1. The Cohort Report

# 1.1. Viewing the Cohort Report

- 1. To start, log into DRDPOnline.org with your username and password.
- 2. On the menu bar to the left, select **Reports** (*Figure 1.1*).

3. In the dropdown menu, select Cohort Progress Report (Figure 1.1-2).

- 4. At the top of the page, several filters require information. *The red asterisk \* indicates which fields are required.*
- 5. The State and Agency fields will automatically populate.
- 6. Select the required Rating Period and Age Group fields (Figure 1.1-3).

- 8. To show the report, select **Show Report**. To download the report, select **Download Report** and choose the PDF option (*Figure 1.1-4 below*).

# 1.2. Domains and Developmental Levels

Only children with completed ratings will show up in specific domains.

1. The first color-coded bar labels the developmental levels (Figure 1.2 below).

2. The domains are listed under the rating bar. The black vertical line shows the median score for the group in that domain (*Figure 1.2-2*).



Figure 1.2-2: Median Score (Black Line) and Percentage and Number of Children Rated at a Developmental Level

The black line shows the median score for the group.

- 3. Under the color bar, there is a number and a percentage representing the percentage and number of children rated within that developmental level (*Figure 1.2-2 above*).
- 4. The "n" on the far left indicates the number of children in the domain rating (*Figure 1.2-3*).

5. For the different rating levels, the percentages and corresponding "n" numbers show the number of children rated in each area for both rating periods.

This report's unique ability is to show the results of two or more rating periods side-by-side and their relationship.

The English Language Development domain's developmental levels differ from the other domains.

### 1.3. Additional Filters

1. Go to **Additional Filters** and select **Subgroups**. This allows you to customize the group or groups you want to see in the report (*Figure 1.2-4 below*).
